

VISIT REPORT OF MR. AMOD K KANTH, GENERAL SECRETARY-PRAYAS TO RANCHI ON 15TH JULY 2016

General Secretary, Prayas arrived at Ranchi on 15th July 2016. The purpose of the visit was to -

- a) Participate as a chief guest in the function organized by J.S.D.M on the occasion of “World Youth Skill Day”
- b) To Inaugurate the India International Skill center approved by N.S.D.C.

The function of World Youth Skill Day was organized at Aryabhata Auditorium at Ranchi University.

Many honorable dignitaries were present in the function to grace the occasion and to share their thoughts,

The programme started with lightening of lamp followed by welcome speech by Mr. Praveen Toppo (Labour Commissioner) in his speech he briefed about the objective of J.S.D.M and how they are willing to help the youth through successfully running the project.

Vice Chancellor (VC) of Ranchi University visited late. He was enthusiastic to be a part of the function and he briefed about skill development. He also added that there has been collaboration with TISS and R.U over skill development.

Ajay Kumar I.A.S gave glimpse about the connectivity of skill and education; he added that if skill training is provided during education than this will add more value and help the students / trainees in their job placement.

Mr. S.K. G Rahate gave valuable inputs over skill development and he also shared information that the office of J.S.D.M will be shifted to the department of technical education.



Our G.S Mr. Amod Kanth began his sentence with informing the audience about Ranchi being his birthplace. His presentation lasted for long duration and his statements were very valuable and informative.

He said that the economy all over the world is dependent upon skill. Skilling generates livelihood and better lifestyle. It generates more source of income affecting economic growth and development. He also emphasized over

- Disconnect between Skill and Education,
- Disconnect between Skill and Community and also
- Disconnect between Skill and Industries.

He explained these to be the major reasons for non Expansion of ‘Skilling’.

He shared his visit to China to know how it became Skill giant globally, as China being one of the leading countries in Skilling and the Economy of China is highly benefitted as employment is not that very big issue as India. He observed that In China there is a Special Cadre of Communist people who are focused to be associated with community and they develop skill as per the need and demand of Industry.

Our G.S in capacity to a chairman of D.W.S.S.C also added his thoughts and experiences. He also said that there has been a joint signature on MOU between Ministry of External Affairs and Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India regarding overseas placement where work permit has been decided to be provided by govt. of India.

After this speech there was a certificate distribution to the trained candidates and the programme came to an End.

Representing all PIAs (training Partner) associated with J.S.D.M, Prayas was asked to represent to share some experiences .Mr.Manoj Kumar Sinha (State head Jharkhand) focused his speech on five important aspects.



1. Provision of Wage loss Compensation to the daily earner.
2. Changing it from non residential to residential.
3. ILO experiences were also shared.
4. ‘Counselling’ facility to be provided to the female trainees before they go for placement outside Ranchi.
5. Meaningful Association of Trainees, Panchayati Raj Institute, Guardians of the trainees.
