The participation included all the members of Prayas Access To Justice Support Persons & District Coordinators of CSA, across various operational areas of the country.

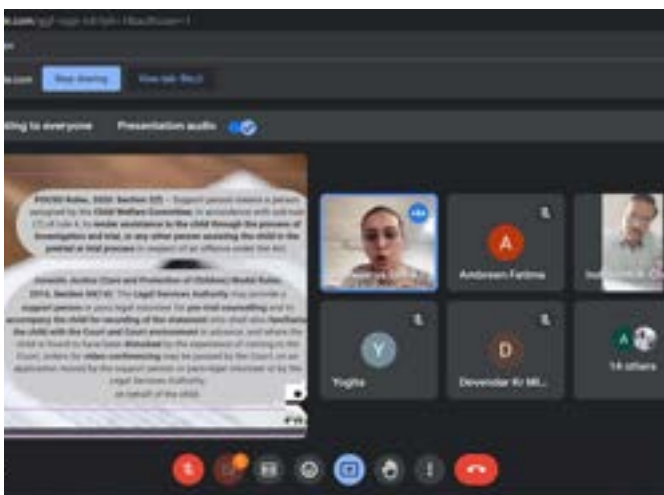

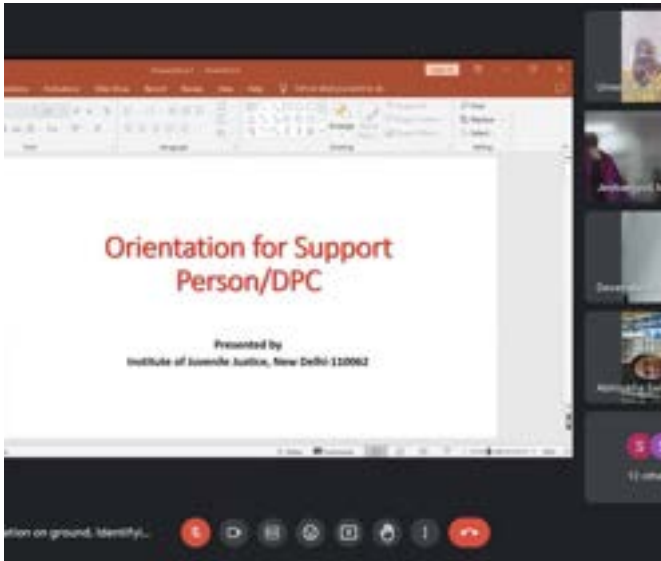

RESCUE OPERATIONS OF THE MONTH

More than 30 children were rescued



BIHAR

Under the instructions of the Labour Resources dept. & Labour Superintendent, Mr. Satya Prakash, a raid operation was conducted in various establishments in Kesariya block of Bihar.

8 children were freed from [#childlabour](#)

Two minor lost children were rescued and handed over to Prayas JAC, East Champaran for further process. The same was informed to the Assistant Director, DCPU. After investigation, the children were later handed over to their parents by Prayas JAC

EAST CHAMPARAN, BIHAR



BIHAR

Two girls were rescued and accommodated in Prayas shelter home. As per the instructions of the NCPDR Child Rights, ND, SSB Anti Human Trafficking Unit, Regional Headquarters, Bettiah was carried out in Rakhai village under Shikarpur PS, Bihar.



AHMEDABAD, GUJARAT

The Ahmedabad-Prayas team and BBA, along with the local police, rescued a child working in a hotel in Raipur. Legal action has been taken against the owner of the hotel and report has been submitted to the CWC.

EAST CHAMPARAN, BIHAR

6 minors were rescued.

The operation was undergone by Railway Protection Force, Raxual. The children were then handed over to Prayas, East Champaran for further necessary action. Among 6, 2 were the residents of East Champaran and 4 were the residents of West Champaran districts. The information on the children was provided by Prayas JAC Society to the District Child Welfare Committee, East Champaran. Abiding by the orders, all the children were accommodated in the Prayas Children's home, Motihari.



EAST CHAMPARAN, BIHAR

Under the leadership of Labour Department, East Champaran an intensive investigation campaign was conducted in various establishments by a special raid team including the members of Prayas JAC, in Motihari Sadar area and rescued 3 minors from Child labour.

Rescued a minor from Child Labour AHTU & FFWC organized a Raid and Rescue in Naroda, Ahmedabad by forming a team in which a minor was rescued. The minor was then accommodated in Prayas Center, abiding the orders of the Child Welfare Committee. Legal action against the shopkeeper was taken at Naroda Police Station.
